



For this assembly. Deepen our lives of prayer. Open us to the guiding of your Spirit. Train us in humility. Fill us with compassion. Nourish us at your holy table. Strengthen us in service to our community. Lord, in your mercy,

hear our prayer.

With thanksgiving we remember those who have died, especially our loved ones and those who have given their lives in service. Inspire us by their example and bring us to your eternal home. Lord, in your mercy,

hear our prayer.

Joining our voices with your faithful ones in every time and place, we offer our prayers in the name of the Risen One, Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**
