Newberry College welcomes nominations and applications for the full-time position of **Campus Pastor** beginning on September 1, 2021. As the leader of spiritual and religious life on campus, the pastor is responsible for nurturing and supporting students, faculty, staff and administration of all faiths and backgrounds. The pastor serves as an advocate for equity, diversity, and inclusion by facilitating opportunities that foster personal and spiritual growth for all members of the Newberry community. The Campus Pastor should be committed to the values of the Newberry experience, including, but not limited to, building a sense of community, clarifying personal faith, liberating the mind and spirit, and promoting responsible leaders for the world. The Campus Pastor will work closely with the College staff and synodical officers to strengthen the relationship between the College and the Lutheran Church. There is also the unique opportunity and expectation to expand the Newberry partnership with other Lutheran Churches located in the City, as well as other faith-based centers in our community.

Requirements:

Minimum requirements for this position include being an ordained minister of Word and Sacrament in the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA), with at least three years' experience as a parish pastor. Preferred qualifications include an appreciation of the history and mission of Newberry College; evidence of a collaborative leadership style that embraces shared governance and builds a culture of trust among faculty, staff, students, alumni and administrators across the College; demonstrated success in developing and implementing traditional and nontraditional student ministry programs; and an interest and commitment to strengthening ties between Newberry College and other ELCA universities and with the four supporting synods (South Carolina, Southeastern, Florida-Bahamas and Caribbean).
