And we didn't (and we won't) raise our camper fees this summer to cover our inflated expenses!

There is an abundance of yet-to-be-filled jobs everywhere and rising salaries, yet there are many across the four synods we serve who have been financially drained by this multi-year pandemic. They have children and youth who need the joy, fellowship, spiritual nurture and so much more that God provides in a week of camp. They need scholarships. We won't turn them away.
