We praise you, Creator of all things.


We worship you, Redeemer of all that lives.





Will you adorn the teaching of our God and Savior by a holy life and conversation?

I will, with God's help.

Will you bear faithful witness before the world, that God's love may be seen in all of you?

I will, with God's help.

The bishop then rededicates himself to the service of God's people All the rostered ministers together then say:

Almighty God, who has given us the will to do these things, bless us with the faith, strength and determination to accomplish them.

Amen.


The bishop concludes the renewal of vows
